## Instructor Course Delivery

### Primary Format – Online (LMS-Based)

The EVOC Instructor Course is delivered online through the TrilogY EMS Learning Management System (LMS).

The course consists of three structured modules:

- 1. TrilogY EMS Instructor Core**  
Foundational instructor development focused on adult learning principles, instructional methodology, documentation standards, and risk management.
- 2. EVOC Provider Online Course**  
Completion of the full EVOC Provider curriculum to ensure instructor mastery of all didactic content prior to teaching.
- 3. Teaching EVOC Module**  
Instructor-specific guidance on delivering EVOC within an agency, including presentation structure, practical evaluation administration, remediation strategies, and safety culture implementation.

Together, these three modules provide a comprehensive training framework to prepare instructors to confidently teach EVOC within their organization.

The LMS format provides:

- Standardized DOT-aligned curriculum delivery
- Instructor-level legal and liability instruction

### **What Instructors Are Authorized To Teach**

Upon successful completion, graduates are authorized to deliver:

- EVOC Provider Course – based on the 1995 DOT National Standard Curriculum, this course is the gold standard for EVOC Certification.
- Agencies may conduct the Provider course entirely in person or utilize the Trilogy LMS to deliver the didactic portion.

# Agency LMS Implementation Option

Agencies certified through the EVOC Instructor Program may purchase EVOC Provider student seats on the Trilogy EMS Learning Management System (LMS).

When utilizing the LMS model, agencies receive:

- A private group training portal
  - Your designated training office representative assigned as Group Administrator
  - Full access to student grades and completion tracking
  - Administrative control over enrollment and training tempo
  - Flexibility to schedule and conduct driving practical assessments based on your schedule

## How the LMS Model Works

1. The agency training office distributes assigned EVOC e-learning access codes to personnel required to attend EVOC training.
  2. Students create a personal profile within the Trilogy EMS Learning Management System (LMS) and redeem the access code provided by their agency.
  3. Upon redemption, the student is automatically enrolled in the agency's private training group within the LMS. The designated Group Administrator has full access to monitor student enrollment, progress, assessment scores, and course completion status in real time.
  4. Students complete the EVOC didactic curriculum online through the Trilogy LMS.
  5. Upon successful completion of the online component, students print their Online Course Completion Certificate. This certificate serves as their admission ticket to the driving practical.
  6. The agency schedules and conducts the driving practical evaluation.
  7. Upon successful completion of the practical assessment, the certified EVOC Instructor authorizes final course completion within the LMS.
  8. The LMS issues the official EVOC Provider Certification directly to the student and maintains permanent training records for documentation purposes.
